The HEN-GEAR initiative is aimed to support Armenian universities in identifying tools and methodologies to improve the effectiveness of the higher education system through the implementation, at local level, of the database of Armenian graduates inspired by the AlmaLaurea model in Italy. Conceived as a matching system between demand for and supply of qualified labour, the system allows companies to search for graduates to be hired on the basis of specific skill needs, also allowing the graduates a more democratic access to the labor market.

- To provide universities and policy makers with an effective tool for monitoring the long lasting impact of higher education on society and for the improvement of the educational supply
- To promote employability networking between the education system and the business sector
